

Introducing "Tot and Me" at Calvary Lutheran Preschool!

What is "Tot and Me"? "Tot and Me" is a program designed for young toddlers and their parents or caregivers. The target age for "Tot and Me" is approximately 18 months-30 months old.

What is the program like at "Tot and Me"? The program includes storytime, music activities, free exploratory play, and a sensory or art experience,, all centered around a weekly early childhood theme.
